

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR A B.H.S. PARKING PERMIT

Parking at Bucyrus High School is a privilege. Each permit holder needs to meet attendance and disciplinary requirements. These requirements must be met throughout the year or the student's parking permit may be revoked. The attendance and discipline from the last nine weeks will be used to determine eligibility for a permit for the first nine weeks of the following year. All student fees from the previous year must be paid before being given a permit. Not paying the current school year's fees may result in loss of parking privileges. Once a student is granted a parking permit they will have to re-submit an application each year to renew the permit. (Without additional Charges.) When re-submitting their application they must write their permit number on the application.

Attendance Requirements:

- No more than 3 absences per nine weeks.
- No more than 4 tardies per nine weeks.

Disciplinary Requirements:

- No more than 4 discipline occurrences per nine weeks, excluding suspensions which may involve loss of parking privilege immediately.
- The administration has the authority to remove a parking permit for other attendance or disciplinary reasons.

DRUG TESTING:

Any student wanting a parking permit must first have a school drug test and be involved in random drug testing for the entire year. Failure to pass a random drug test will result in the same consequences, loss of parking permit (20%), 20 hours community service, assessment by a certified drug-alcohol counselor.

PARKING PERMIT PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

(PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY)

- 1 The permit must be properly displayed at all times on school grounds.
- 2 Cars without permits will not be permitted on school property between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on school days. Students who park without permits will be subject to disciplinary action and/or loss of parking privilege present or future. Cars without permits may be towed at the owner's expense.
- 3 Neither temporary nor permanent permits are transferable from person to person without administrative permission.
- 4 Reckless operation of any motor vehicle will result in loss of parking privileges.
- 5 Students parking in an unauthorized area or parking in a manner that is not orderly will face disciplinary actions and/or loss of parking privilege.
- 6 Student parking will be permitted ONLY in the paved lot at the West end of the school. Under no circumstances are students permitted to park anywhere else on school property.

- 7 No one is to loiter in cars in the parking area. A pass must be secured from the office to go to the parking lot during school hours.
- 8 If a student is excused to leave school property, he/she may not take additional students unless they also are permitted to leave school and parent permission has been received.
- 9 Any student who drives off of school property during school hours without permission will lose their permit.
- 10 All motorcycles and motorbikes operating on school property must also have a parking permit.
- 11 School Buses always have the right of way. At the end of the day when buses leave the parking lot all traffic must stop to let them leave. Violation of this rule will result in disciplinary action and/or loss of parking privilege.
- 12 Students cannot use the East exits of the paved lot at the end of the school day.
- 13 Traffic flows around the circle in a counter-clockwise direction only.
- 14 Vehicles parked in the Bucyrus High School Parking lots are subject to search where cause exists.
- 15 Bucyrus City Schools are not responsible for damage or loss incurred on school property. Park at your own risk. Lost or stolen permits replaced at owner's expense.
- 16 Any violation of the above procedures and/or regulations may result in any combination of the following actions; loss of parking privilege, disciplinary action, and towing of vehicle at owners expense.
- 17 Disciplinary action for violations of the student code of conduct or violations of the attendance policy may also result in loss of parking privilege.

- I understand that a qualified vendor will oversee the collection process.
- I understand that any urine samples will be sent only to a certified medical laboratory for actual testing, and the samples will be coded to provide confidentiality.
- I hereby give our consent to the medical vendor selected by the Bucyrus City School Board, their laboratory, doctors, employees, or agents, together with any clinic, hospital, or laboratory designated by the selected medical vendor to perform urinalysis testing for the detection of illicit drugs or banned substances.
- I further give permission to the medical vendor selected by the Bucyrus City School Board, its doctors, employees, or agents, to release all results of these tests to the Medical Review Officer (MRO) working for the medical vendor. We understand these results will be forwarded to the Building Principal and will also be made available to us.
- I understand that consent pursuant to this Informed Consent Agreement will be effective for all activities in which this student might participate during the current school year.
- I hereby release the Bucyrus City School Board of Education, SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc. and its employees from any legal responsibility or liability for the release of such information and records.
